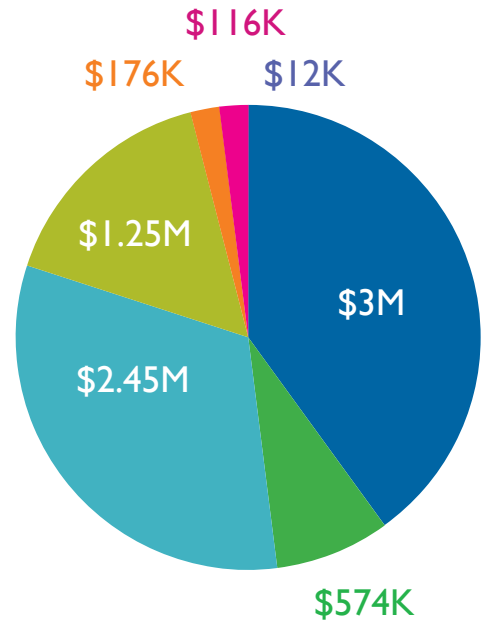


2020 Summary of Financial Revenue
